

Myth 3#: Automation eliminates ALL bottlenecks


- Continuous Delivery pipeline unending feedback loops.

Myth 5#: All about Tools


- Mandating tools developers can use.

- Legacy companies Can be on high-level of maturity on Continuous Delivery


